Developed and trialed in Australia between 2010 and 2014 the program is now most active in China, with trained facilitators working in Austria, England and the USA.

Jump up has been successfully adapted to run in schools, holiday camps and family homes; inspiring parents, teachers and children alike.

JUMP UP PROGRAM TOPICS

The following curriculum and core subjects are covered throughout the program:

WHO AM I? The miracle of life in human form! (Science and History)

WHO ARE WE? Humans are an interdependent part of the web of life. (Science)

WHAT DO WE NEED? Sufficiency for health and wellbeing. (Maths, Civics and Citizenship)

WHAT IS OUR STORY? Cultural traditions and stories inform our world views and assumptions. Throughout history our human stories change. (History, Civics, and Citizenship)

WHERE ARE WE? The children's perspectives of what they see in their local communities and the world at large. (Civics and Citizenship, History, Math, Critical Thinking and Analysis)

HOW DID WE GET HERE? Exploring unexamined assumptions and world views within the classroom. (Civics and Citizenship, Critical Thinking and Analysis)

WHAT IS EMERGING? Global perspectives - Local action. Researching and connecting with organisations working for sustainability, justice and wellbeing.

WHAT ACTION CAN I TAKE? Designing individual, group, and class action learning projects that inspire change.

INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

Jump Up adopts a universal perspective within the early years classroom by drawing on the wisdom of traditional cultures and the discoveries of modern science.

By implementing intergenerational theories of change, partnership education and learning enquiry throughout our materials and delivery the program ensures cultural inclusion and multi domain outcomes.

Integrated assessment tools evaluate student progress in core curriculum areas (science, history, math, languages, civics and citizenship, critical thinking and analysis) enabling your school to easily report on each child's learning outcomes.
